PARKS AND PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES *PROPOSED* September 27, 2022

The Parks and Public Works Committee met for Regular Committee Meeting at 10:00 a.m. City Hall 102 Butler St., Saugatuck, MI 49453.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dean at 10:00 a.m.

Approval of Agenda:

Review/Discussion:

- A. Kickoff Comments from Chairman Dean:
 - a. Chairman Dean stated he is excited to be presiding over the Parks & Public Works Committee in more than a decade.
