**SUBJECT:** Proposed Social District Signage

#### **Description:**

City Council requested an opportunity to review the proposed signage for the Social District boundaries. Attached are two designs, one for the signs which will be firmly secured on metal post. The sign material will be metal. Improvements to the sign will include a QR code and larger text listing the Social District rules.

The other sign comes in the form of a sticker and designed for placement on sidewalks at certain boundaries (picture attached). Stickers will be utilized in locations where installing a metal sign is challenging and will be used in combination with the metal sign along main roadways.

Receptacles will be placed at the Social District boundaries on main roadways where none currently exist.
