The City Council met for a Workshop Meeting at 4:00 p.m. City Hall 102 Butler St., Saugatuck, MI 49453.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stanton at 4:00 p.m.

Discussion Items:

AT&T Presentation:

Ken Berthiaume, City Auditor presented the 2023 City audit:

- Audit work went very smoothly.
- They received excellent help and cooperation from City staff, especially Treasurer Stanislawski.
- City bookkeeping is in excellent shape.
- The audit has been submitted to the State of Michigan.
- Comparing 2023 revenues and expenses to 2022, positive net position.
- Property tax increase over prior year by 6%.
- Investment earnings were substantially higher this year.
- General government expenses went up 30%.
- \$250,000 more expense in category of general government.
- Legal fees increased for a total of \$629,000 for the year.

- \$10,500,000 held in cash and investments, \$6,900,000 million invested with Michigan class. Earned about \$300,000 last year.
- Unrestricted net position \$6,923,000.00, \$150,000.00 higher than prior year.
- Restricted net position \$3,100,000.
- General fund balance came in at \$5,057,000 with annual budget is about \$3,500,000.

AT&T Lease:

- City attorneys have been negotiating the tower structure lease agreement.
- The substantive terms of the agreement are in place with a little bit more that needs to be figured out.
- The City Council will go into closed session to discuss the lease amounts.
- The current red-line lease was presented to Council.

Dunce Ridge Update:

• There has been an order issued by the Court of Appeals, not a final order, but it's something to update the Council about and some correspondence from Dune Ridge via closed session.

Closed Session:

Motion by Anderson, second by Muncey to move into closed session pursuant to MCL 15.286(h) to discuss a confidential written legal opinion regarding a potential lease agreement with AT&T. Via roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Baldwin, second by Dean to move into closed session pursuant to MCL 15.268(e) and (h) to discuss a confidential written legal opinion regarding the ongoing lawsuit with Dune Ridge SA, LP. Via roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Council entered closed session at 4:22 p.m.
