The City of Saugatuck will hold a public meeting on the proposed Water System Improvements project for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The purpose of the proposed project is improvements to the City's water system.

Project construction will involve replacement of approximately 538 lead service lines, replacing 2.0 miles of aging or undersized watermain at various locations throughout the City, improvements at Wellhouse No. 5, and improvements to the overflow pipe at the concrete reservoir.

Impacts of the proposed project include minor traffic operation and increased local noise and dust levels typical of a construction project. There are no anticipated long-term impacts from this project.

The estimated cost to users for the proposed project will be dependent on the terms of the financing proposed by EGLE for this project. The estimated project costs are totaled to be approximately \$16 million.
